Joshua 10:1-14

In this text we discover that the sun literally stood still for the people of God to fight their battle. God altered the course of a day so that His children might know that until the sun sets, there is still time. In like fashion, every Christian can seize the day by examining three truths we discover in Joshua 10:1-14.

Until the sun sets, there is still:

1. _____ for God _____

And the Lord said to Joshua, “Do not fear them, for I have given them into your hands. Not a man of them shall stand before you.” Joshua 10:8

2. _____ in God _____

And the Lord threw them into a panic before Israel, **who struck them** with a great blow at Gibeon and **chased them** by the way of the ascent of Beth-horon and struck them as far as Azekah and Makkedah.

Joshua 10:10

And as they fled before Israel, while they were going down the ascent of Beth-horon, the **Lord threw down large stones from heaven** on them as far as Azekah, and they died. **There were more who died because of the hail-stones** than the sons of Israel killed with the sword.

3. _____ for God _____

At that time Joshua spoke to the Lord in the day when the Lord gave the Amorites over to the sons of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, "Sun, stand still at Gibeon, and moon, in the Valley of Aijalon."
