Joshua 10:16-27

In this text we discover that the sun literally stood still for the people of God to fight their battle. In life, you and I have some battles that we have to fight. We have some real enemies who desire to see our destruction. This is not just a story for us to review, but this passage contains practical lessons in how we can overthrow our enemies. We conquer our enemies:

but do not stay there yourselves. Pursue your enemies; attack their rear guard. Do not let them enter their cities, **for the Lord your God has given them into your hand.** Joshua 10:19

And Joshua said to them, "Do not be afraid or dismayed; be strong and courageous. **For thus the Lord will do to all your enemies against whom you fight.**" Joshua 10:25

2. _____ *the work of God's* _____.

And Joshua said, "**Roll large stones against the mouth of the cave and set men by it to guard them,**" Joshua 10:18

"Then Joshua said, "**Open the mouth of the cave and bring those five kings out to me from the cave.**"" Joshua 10:22

"**And they did so,** and brought those five kings out to him from the cave, **the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, and the king of Eglon.**" Joshua 10:23

3. _____ *the witness of God's* _____.

And Joshua captured all these kings and their land at one time, **because the Lord God of Israel fought for Israel.** Joshua 10:42
